- Do you have an old refrigerator or freezer wasting energy? Residential electric customers who recycle their old, inefficient refrigerators or freezers through the Mass Save appliance recycling program will be offered a no-cost pickup plus, a \$100 rebate. Enhanced rebate of \$100 available for a limited time, July 1 September 1 (scheduled pick up date before October 31, 2019). The following eligibility requirements apply:
 - > For active, Unitil residential electric account holders.
 - Refrigerators and freezers must be working, plugged in, clean and empty at the time of pickup.
 - > Refrigerators and freezers must have an inside measurement between 10 and 30 cubic feet, which is the standard size for most units.
 - > A maximum of two units per electric account per calendar year will be accepted.

Older refrigerators and freezers use less efficient technology, which can increase energy costs by up to \$150 a year compared to newer models. That means you will save by upgrading or getting rid of an old unit. Plus, participating in the Mass Save appliance recycling program ensures your unit is responsibly recycled.
