### From the Director:

#### Dear Ashby,

For anyone that attended the Ashby Town Meeting last month, or took a look at the COA's budget for FY2020, you'll know that the COA's town budget was increased for next year to include more hours for the Director position from 3 hours to 8 hours per week. With the money we receive from the State, the Director position is now funded for a total of 13 hours per week. The increase is good news and the COA and myself are very thankful for the efforts of everyone that helped to make that increase happen.

The bad news is that the COA is still underfunded. Based upon community feedback, senior population totals now and in 5 years, and our seniors' needs, the COA requested 16 hours per week for a Director for upcoming FY2020. Unfortunately, the decision was made to not meet that request. Ultimately, the Ashby COA is not adequately funded for FY2020. Here is the breakdown of the COA's budget for FY2020:

- The COA's total town budget = \$7,897.00
- Anticipated grant funding from the State = \$6,000
- Total anticipated COA budget for FY2020 = \$13,897

The COA will have some hard decisions to make as to how best to use our limited budget to meet the needs of Ashby's growing senior population. We plan to continue move the COA forward and we welcome your feedback, input, and participation. Please attend an upcoming COA meeting, the second Wednesday of each month at 3:30 at the Town Hall. Hope to see you there!

### Good to Know:

### Ashby P.D. Tip of the Month: TEXT TO 911

Text to 911 is now available throughout the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. All Massachusetts 911 call centers now have the ability to receive a text message through their 911 system.

Text to 911 allows those in need of emergency services to use their cellular device to contact 911 when they are unable to place a voice call. To contact emergency services by text message, simply enter 911 in the "To" field of your mobile device and then type your message into the message field. It is the same process that is used for sending a regular text message from your mobile device.

It is important to make every effort to **begin the text message indicating the town you are in** and provide the best location information that you can. The

State 911 Department encourages citizens to text to 911 only when a voice call is not possible. This is also perfect for deaf or hard of hearing citizens to communicate with our 911 dispatchers.

### Remember: "Call if you can, text if you can't."
